Question: What is the difference between a concentraion pause on floor vs beam?

Answer: A concentration pause on Beam is .10 deduction for pause less 2 seconds. More than 2 second pause is .2 each. Concentration pause on FX for 2 seconds or more is each .10

*Xcel Bars dismount 8.005 (Tap swing 1/2 -1/2 dismount) touch of hand is required for skill recognition

Canon Corner

Canon 5:

Judges should be alert at all times, quickly and accurately produce their scores and be prepared to support their score in a professional manner.

Canon 6

Judges should not solicit meets for themselves or others.

Everyone is responsible for their own scoring/scripting method. There is a handbook and other tools on the NAWGJ website to assist with learning how to script both skills and deductions. Here is a link to shorthand help (https://nawgj.org/judging-aids/shorthand-helps/). No one else needs to interpret your scripting and deduction methodology, but you. If you are new to scripting skills, start with one new skill each session you judge and use it every time you see it.

*Copper Beam - Lever/T has no angle requirement. Levering action not required to touch beam. Example: Level 1 Needle kick fulfills acro requirement.

> *When doing a lever for Bronze the back leg must be horizontal or above.
